




EU Research and Innovation Funding









- Horizon Europe (FP9)
 - EUR 95 billion for 2021-2027
- Digital Europe Programme (DEP)
 - EUR 7.5 billion for 2021-2027
 - building strategic capacities
 - deploying digital technologies
- Status of Switzerland
 - targeting "associated country", as in Horizon 2020
 - However, Switzerland is currently a third country with respect to Horizon Europe





Swiss entities (industry, SMEs, universities, research organisations, ...) can participate in Horizon Europe

Because of the third country status of Switzerland with respect to Horizon Europe:


- The participation in mono-beneficiary programmes such as the EIC Accelerator is currently not possible
- Swiss participants can currently not coordinate projects
- Swiss participants are currently not eligible to participate in most of the Coordination and Support Actions (CSAs)

Funding for Swiss participants is provided by the Swiss State Secretariat for Education, Research and Innovation (SERI)







Use the Funding & Tender Opportunities Portal to:

- Find suitable topics
- Consult reference documents:
 - Work programmes as PDF documents
 - Legal framework, call conditions
 - General annexes
 - Templates: application forms, evaluation forms
 - Grant agreements
- Read topic-related FAQs
- Submit proposals
- Manage running projects







- Develop your network, profile yourself as reliable and sought-after project partner
- LinkedIn has a number of groups frequently used for Horizon
 Europe partner search, for example "Horizon Europe, Industry 4.0
 and Digitalisation". Use the search term "Horizon Europe".
- Use the numerous brokerage events organized for example by <u>Enterprise Europe Network</u>
- The <u>Cordis Database</u> has a list of all Horizon 2020 and Horizon Europe projects: look for consortium partners among previously successful applicants






Horizon Europe – Your Journey






Other Funding Instruments

European Institute of Innovation & Technology (EIT), opportunities







- Eurostars is a funding instrument supporting international collaborative R&D and innovation projects under the lead of an innovative SME
- For Swiss participants the funding rate is: 50% for SMEs, 20% for large companies and 50% for universities and R+D institutions
- Next Deadline for Submission of Proposals: 24 March 2022


